# The Meaning of Care and Care Work in Nunavut





With support from the Canadian Centre for Caregiving Excellence, Nunavummi Disabilities Makinnasuagtiit Society travelled across Nunavut to conduct the first study of its kind to consult with Nunavut's 25 communities on disability and care.

## About the participants

**Care** is one of the top three most pressing areas of concern among Nunavummiut, alongside transportation and community-based support for people with disabilities.

**543** Nunavummiut participated in group and individual interviews



88% of our participants identified as Inuk (Inuit)
